



It is a requirement under the Health (Drinking water) Amendment Act 2007 to ensure that backflow prevention devices are tested and proven to be operational. Customers have a choice regarding whether they make their own arrangements to have their device tested by an IQP or whether they have their device tested by Watercare. Test certificates for boundary and containment devices must be received by Watercare. If this is not received, then Watercare will arrange to have the device tested. The customer is responsible for the costs of the tests.
