AMatthews outlined his involvement in reporting on the heritage of the four Watercare Filter Stations that are identified in the Auckland Unitary Plan as historic buildings for Watercare. He explained the rationale behind the listing and the heritage values of the buildings and components. He agreed after general discussion as to "where we go from here" to undertake a new site visit and to report back to the CLG, his findings. The CLG also requested that the report on the cost of earthquake strengthening the building be updated – this was agreed to by Watercare. These reports would then allow a subgroup within the CLG to consider the merits in retaining the building, any possible repurposing, demolition, etc. A Mathews to provide to the CLG a plan of the areas of the Huia and Nihotupu Filter Station buildings that are category B.
